## **Summary/Description:**

As part of the budget development process for FY2014-15, the school administration has conducted several community budget meetings in order to share information and receive comments about next year's budget. As a result of those meetings, the school administration prepared a tiered budget proposal to present to the school board on December 3, 2013.

During the last school board meeting, the school administration shared information with the school board regarding the governor's proposed budget which includes additional funding for schools. Since this information was received just prior to that school board meeting, the school administration asked for the opportunity to incorporate compensation scenarios for employees and other items into the tier options already presented to the school board. That information will be provided during this presentation.

- First day of student attendance as August 25, 2014

- Eleven teacher professional development/planning dates
- Six early dismissal days to provide teachers with additional planning time
- Three orientation days for new teachers
- Seven pre-school workdays for all staff
- Election Day, November 4, 2014, as a holiday for all employees

The start date for this calendar assumes a pre-Labor Day waiver continuation as has occurred for the previous two years.



## **Summary/Description:**

In May 2013, the school administration began the process of converting the Lynchburg City School Board Policies and Administrative Regulations to the Virginia School Boards Association's policies. As a member of the VSBA Policy Services, the school division receives regular updates to policies which coincide with changes to the Code of Virginia. Further, all policies developed by the VSBA are reviewed by legal counsel.

The first section in the conversion process was approved June 4, 2013. The second section regarding community relations will be presented to the school board for discussion this evening. Revisions and substitutions to this section have been reviewed by the city attorney's office to ensure that they are legally sound.
