





2011-2012 Grade Distribution





2011-2012 Grade Distribution

Math Grades 3-5









2011-2012 Grade Distribution

Science Grades 3-5









2011-2012 Grade Distribution






Suspensions by Race











2011-2012 Disciplinary Referrals by Gender


