

SCHOOL BOARD BYLAWS

Vacancies: Officers P 1-21

In the event that the chairman should vacate his/her office, prior to expiration of a term, the vice-chairman shall fill the position of chairman for the remainder of the term.

Should any other officer of the school board vacate his office, the school board shall, at the next regular meeting following the acceptance of such notice, elect from their membership a new officer; except in the instance where the office of the clerk or deputy clerks shall be fulfilled in the same manner in which they were originally elected.

Legal Reference:

The Code of Ordinate of the City of Lynchburg, Virginia. § 32-16. Board of School Trustees--Appointment and Term. On or before March 1, 1976, the council shall appoint from the electors of the city from each school district established pursuant to the state law, three (3) school trustees, whose terms shall commence March 1, 1976. From each school district one school trustee shall be elected for a term ending June 30, 1976, one for a term ending June 30, 1977, and one for a term ending June 30, 1978. Within thirty (30) days preceding the expiration of the terms expiring June 30, 1976, and annually thereafter, within thirty (30) days of the expiration of the term of each trustee, the council shall appoint a successor to each such trustee in office, whose term shall commence when the term of such predecessor shall have expired and who shall hold his office for a term of three (3) years.
