

SCHOOL BOARD BYLAWS

Complaints P 1-25A. Regarding Students or Employees of the School Board

Upon written request to the superintendent, the school board may honor a request of an individual or group that desires to speak or present complaints at a school board meeting. The request must specify the reason for speaking to the school board.

The chairman shall rule such speaker to be out of order until the complainant has complied with the guidelines and School Board Policies 5-3, and 7-6 and Administrative Regulations 5-3, and 7-6.
