

## SCHOOL BOARD BYLAWS

A. Adoption and Amendment

Bylaws proposals and suggested amendments to or revisions of existing bylaws shall be by majority vote of members of the school board at two consecutive regular meetings. The proposed additions, amendments, or revisions shall have been described in writing prior to their consideration at the first meeting.

B. Suspension

Bylaws of the school board shall be subject to suspension only upon a majority vote of the total membership (five votes) of the school board in a meeting at which the proposed suspension has been described in writing. When no such written notice has been given, changes may be made upon a majority plus one vote (six votes) of the total membership of the school board.

Legal Reference:

Code of Va., § 22.1-78. Bylaws and regulations.--"A school board may adopt bylaws and regulations, not inconsistent with State statutes and regulations of the Board of Education, for its own government, for the management of its official business and for the supervision of schools, including but not limited to the proper discipline of students, including their conduct going to and returning from school."
