

SCHOOL BOARD BYLAWS

The superintendent shall assist the school board by preparing the annual report for the State Board covering the work of the schools for the previous year.

Legal Reference:

Code of Va., § 22.1-81. Annual report.--" Unless for good cause shown an extension of time not to exceed fifteen days is granted by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, each school board, with the assistance of the division superintendent, shall, on or before September 15 of each year, make a report covering the work of the schools for the year ending the preceding June 30 to the Board of Education on forms supplied by the Superintendent of Public Instruction."
