

SCHOOL BOARD BYLAWS

Special Meetings P 1-39

Special or called meetings of the school board may be held whenever the school board in session may decide, at the call of the chairman, the call of the school division superintendent, or at the request of two or more members. No business other than that stated in the call shall be transacted at special meetings unless two-thirds of the total membership of the school board is in attendance and the motion receives a majority plus one vote of those present.
