

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

A. Generally

Citizens' advisory committees will be organized by the board when mandated by Virginia law and regulations of the State Board of Education or whenever the board determines that such groups may be helpful in determining the board's policies and in putting them into effect.

B. Nominations to the Committees

Board members in cooperation with the superintendent will compile a list of prospective candidates for the committees.

The persons selected should be competent and school-minded. They should be interested in the welfare of the community to the extent that they are willing to give time and effort to the study of vital problems. The committees should be as truly representative of the community served by the schools as possible.

C. Service of the Committees

Activities and discussion shall be confined to the compilation of data, the analyses of problems, the summary of opinions, and to the drawing of conclusions.

Committees and their chairmen shall exercise no function legally with the jurisdiction of the board or of its officers, nor shall they assume to exercise any supervision over any board employee.
