

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Fund Raising by Students P 2-32A. Community Projects

No school-related organization shall engage in fund raising projects or solicitations in the community without prior approval of the superintendent.

B. In-School Projects

The individual school principal may use his/her own discretion in approving or disapproving in-school fund-raising projects. These are projects in which students are involved either within the school day or as scheduled before and/or after school. Projects in this category take place on the school premises or where a sanctioned school function is being held.

Legal Reference

Virginia State Board of Education Regulations "Governing the Accreditation of Public Schools in Virginia."

At Standard D, Criterion #18 "Fund-raising activities which involve elementary students in door-to-door solicitation shall be prohibited and so stated in the school handbook." (1991)
