

## COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Lynchburg City School Board encourages the use of the auditoriums, gymnasiums, other areas, and appurtenances of school buildings by reliable community agencies, institutions, organizations, and responsible individuals for civic, cultural, religious, recreational, and for limited commercial purposes, subject to certain terms and conditions, and provided it does not interfere with regular school functions and operations.

Legal Reference:

Code of Va., § 22.1-131. Boards may permit use of school property; general conditions.--"A school board may permit the use, upon such terms and conditions as it deems proper, of such school property as will not impair the efficiency of the schools. The school board may authorize the division superintendent to permit use of the school property under such conditions as it deems proper. The division superintendent shall report to the school board at the end of each month his actions under this section. Permitted uses may include use as voting places in any primary, regular or special election and operation of a local or regional library pursuant to an agreement between the school board and a library board created as provided in § 42.1-35 of this Code." (1980)

Code of Va., § 22.1-132. Boards may impose certain specific conditions.--Permits for the use of school property may contain, among other matters, (i) provisions limiting the use of the property while classes are in session and (ii) an undertaking by the lessee to return the property so used in as good condition as when leased, normal wear and tear excepted." (1980)
