

STUDENTS

An appeal is the act of expressing an objection to a condition, a circumstance, or a punishment imposed by a teacher or school administrator. For the purposes of this policy, appeal means those objections beyond the normal discussion and questioning that a student or parent/guardian might pursue with a teacher or administrator.

The parent(s) or legal guardian of any student may initiate an appeal. A student who has reached age eighteen may initiate an appeal as can his/her parent or legal guardian.

The superintendent shall develop administrative procedures to be used by a person making an appeal with steps reaching to the school board.
