Conduct: Alternative or Adult Education Placement

The superintendent, or his designee, may require a student to attend an alternative or adult education program consistent with the provisions of Policy 7-33.1 after providing the following:

1. written notice to the student and his parent that the student will be required to attend an alternative or adult education program, and
2. notice of the opportunity for the student and parent to participate in a hearing to be conducted by the superintendent or his designee regarding such placement.

The decision of the superintendent or his designee regarding such alternative or adult education placement shall be final unless altered by the school board through appeal. The request for an appeal must be submitted in writing within 15 days of the date of the decision. The appeal will be a review of the records unless otherwise requested by the school board.
