Throughout the month of November, the TC Miller Eagles are focusing on honesty. Honesty means you are truthful even when it is difficult.


We will be recognizing honest students in our monthly Terrific Kid Celebration on November 29<sup>th</sup> at 2:45. We are looking forward to soaring through November!
